



Duraphat[®] 2800 ppm Fluoride Toothpaste

Patient information

You have been prescribed Duraphat 2800 ppm Fluoride Toothpaste by your dental professional.



The following information has been prepared to answer some of the questions you may have in relation to this toothpaste.

What is this toothpaste?

It is a high fluoride toothpaste for use at home providing protection against tooth decay for adults and children aged 10 years and over. Duraphat 2800 ppm Fluoride Toothpaste contains almost twice the fluoride level of a regular toothpaste.

Why do I need this toothpaste?

Your dental professional has diagnosed you with increased risk for tooth decay and has decided that you would benefit from using toothpaste containing a higher level of fluoride than regular toothpaste. This toothpaste is clinically proven to be more effective than a regular toothpaste at preventing tooth decay. This prescribed toothpaste is for your personal use only and should not be shared with anyone else.

How does this toothpaste work?

The higher fluoride levels can help prevent tooth decay by inhibiting demineralisation and promoting remineralisation of the tooth surface.

How should I use this toothpaste?

Please always read the package leaflet before using the product.

Use Duraphat 2800 ppm Fluoride Toothpaste instead of your regular toothpaste. Apply a 1cm line of toothpaste across the head of a toothbrush and brush thoroughly for one minute, morning and evening.

Spit out after use. For the best results, do not drink or rinse for 30 minutes after brushing.

Where can I get this toothpaste from?

Duraphat 2800 ppm Fluoride Toothpaste is a prescription only medicine. NHS prescriptions will be dispensed at your pharmacy.
